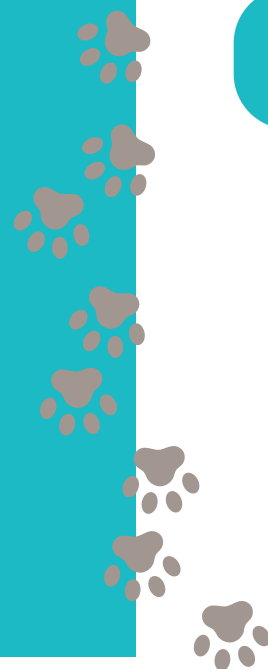
OUR MISSION & VALUES

Values: Innovation • Compassion • Integrity • Teamwork • Courage & Commitment

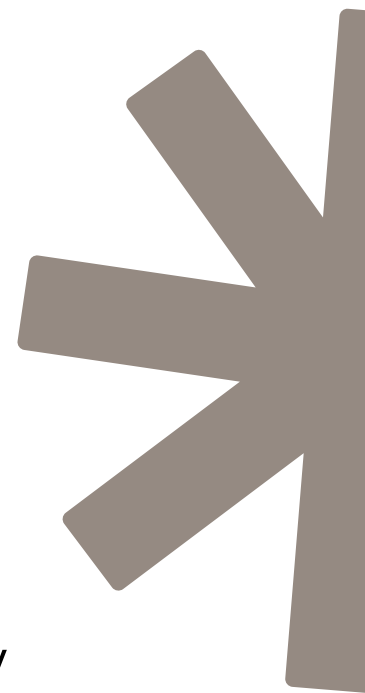
Vision: A community where pet owners have consistent support and affordable access to care, and all pets are healthy and loved.





YEAR AT A GLANCE

- Over 30,000 pets & their caregivers benefitted from our programs
- 1,653 veterinary procedures provided at no cost
- 670+ families received free pet food
- Program impacts across Marion County and surrounding counties





KEY PROGRAMS OVERVIEW

- **Community Clinic:** Provided low-cost and free veterinary care to pets in need, increasing access to affordable veterinary care. Partnered with Bissell Foundation and Marion County Board of Commissioners to expand program opportunities.
- **Pet Food Bank:** Partnered with Chewy to continue to bring nutritious food to our community's pets and aid partner nonprofits to feed and care for homeless pets
- **Rescue & Adoptions:** Rescued pets from our local community and found them loving homes
- **Trap-Neuter-Return:** Assisted colony caregivers in sterilization of community cats

WHO WE SERVE



VOCAL is committed to providing services to pet owners and caregivers who need access to low-cost veterinary care. Spay-neuter surgery, dentals, vaccinations, and preventatives make up the bulk of our current services.

Additionally, we offer low-cost emergency pyometra surgeries on a regular basis, as well as occasional specialty surgeries like mass removals and amputations. Our services are **not** restricted to low-income or Marion County clients.

We also serve clients looking to adopt. Our adoption program places pets with companions as we act as a match-making service.

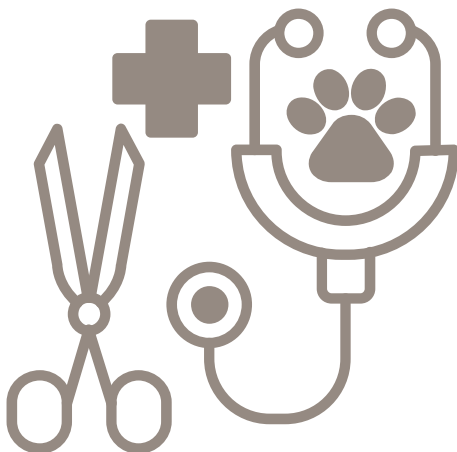
In addition to local pet owners, we also provide Pet Food to:

- 115,000 lbs of pet food distributed to local families
- 1 million lbs of pet food and supplies distributed to over 70 other rescues & nonprofits

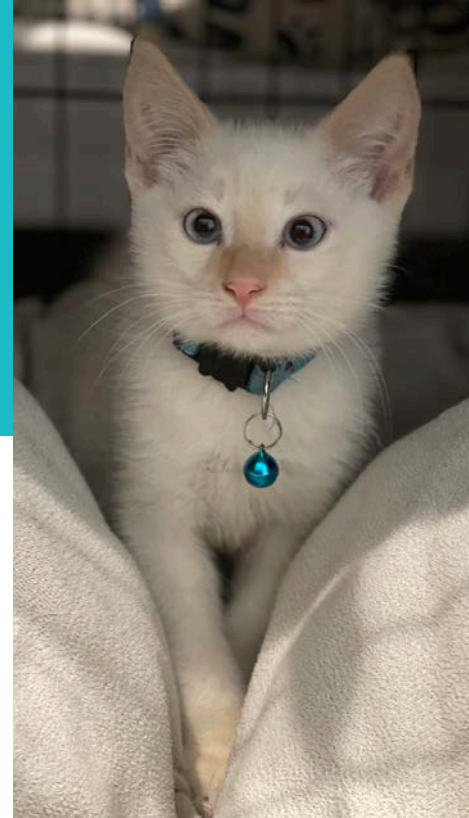
We participate in the Community Foundation's 2-day fundraiser every year, typically with a specific goal in mind.

The Furball is our annual gala, with a theme that changes annually. The community's most generous donors look forward to celebrating with us each year.

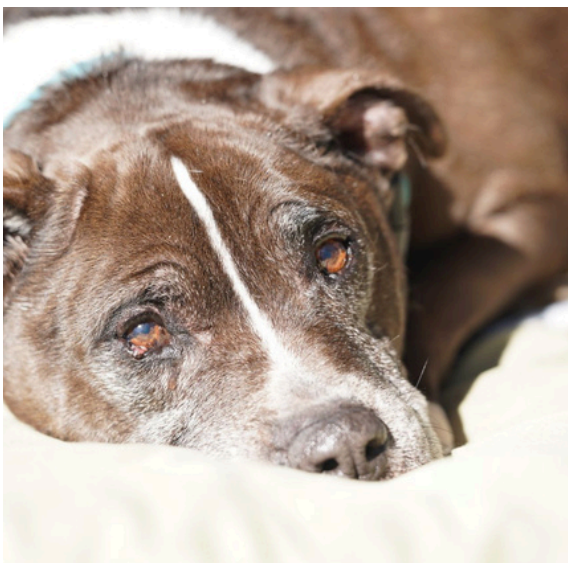
